Please note that for the Wyoming section of production we will be shooting in the Big Horn Mountains, a very rural part of Wyoming where the nearest town is 20 miles away, and the nearest town with a grocery store is 50 miles away. We will be working 10 – 12 hour days, six days per week. We will be staying at a private ranch and there will be some 'roughing it' in terms of limited shower availability, sharing of rooms, etc. If any of this would make you feel uncomfortable, please do not apply. If however you feel that you can be flexible and amenable to

these conditions we welcome your application. On this production you will get to spend time in some of the most beautiful and remote country in America.

The number of crew we can take with us on location will be dependent on our final budget. Final decisions will be made by mid April.
